



Duke of Edinburgh's Award - Expedition Assessors

All D of E expeditions must now be assessed by an accredited assessor. This involves attending an initial training day, followed by a supported assessment of a group.

The next training day will take place at Girlguiding NEE HQ, Monks Cross, York on February 25th 2012, from 10am to 4pm. The cost will be £20.

Prior to attending the day it is essential to complete the registration form and return it to NEE HQ by January 20th - as all applicants must be confirmed with D of E HQ before the course takes place. The forms are available from NEE HQ, or are on the website. Please note you must include a passport sized photo - they will not be taken on the day.

Becoming an assessor is a step which will help to support our young people who are taking part in the award. However before attending the course you do need some experience of working with D of E expeditions. We also expect you to hold the relevant qualification for the level of country you wish to assess in - so for example a Silver assessor would be expected to have level 2 walking or equivalent for alternative means of travel.
