A	<p>Compile a booklet called "101 things to do in xxxx" (your local town/area). It could be aimed at a specific age group, e.g. children or families, or just everyone. Think about including facilities for the disabled, etc. You could distribute them by putting them in local Tourist Information Centres or sell them (at a reasonable price!) for a local charity.</p>	Several meetings	GS
B	 <p>Collect 101 pieces of litter (each for SS & Guides) (per six/group for Brownies/Rainbows) from a public area. N.B. Use plastic gloves!</p>	60 mins	RBGS
C	<p>Invite someone to lead a flower arranging session. Donate the arrangements to a good cause.</p> <p>Rainbows/Brownies/Guides: Take them to an old people's home. Guides/SS: Auction/sell the flower arrangements and give the money to a worthy cause.</p> 	60 mins+	RBGS
D	 <p>Learn to knit and knit something for someone else. Rainbows/Brownies/Guides - knit a square or two to be made into a blanket for a homeless/drop-in centre. Guides/SS knit scarves/hats, etc. for a similar cause.</p>	Several meetings!	RBGS
E	<p>Speak to a local establishment for people with sight disabilities about tactile resources and make tactile pictures they can use with their clients, e.g. special schools, children's centres, etc.</p>	60 mins+	BGS
F	<p>Make Birthday/ Christmas/Easter cards and send them to residents of a home for the elderly. Spare ones could be given to the home to sell for fund-raising.</p>	60 mins+	RBGS
G	<p>Make pictures or collages for a children's hospice or hospital ward. Make bright, happy pictures that will cheer the rooms up. Write notes to the children or patients and see if you could visit them.</p> <p>NB. Check local policy before you begin your displays.</p> 	60 mins+	RBGS
H	 <p>Visit a local place of interest such as a nature reserve or a picnic area. Look at the facilities and think about how they could be improved for different types of visitors and the wildlife. See what you could do about putting these improvements in place, e.g. provide picnic tables or bird feeders, pick litter regularly, design and make information leaflets or plaques, plan and create maps of routes for different walks, etc.</p>	Several meetings Ongoing	RBGS
